INNOVATION RELAUNCHED – On course to responsible business practices

The final event of the Horizon 2020 project [“COMPASS – Evidence and Opportunities for Responsible Innovation in SMEs”](#) will take place in Brussels on March 26, 2019. The event will be a meeting point for companies, researchers in the area of responsible innovation in industry, innovation support organizations and policymakers.

Participants will be introduced to three main outputs of the COMPASS project: 1) the online self-check tool; 2) the co-creation method for roadmap development; and 3) roadmaps towards responsible innovation in nanotechnology, cyber security and biomedicine. They will receive first-hand accounts from pioneer companies, as well as have the opportunity to share their own experiences with responsible innovation in companies.

Program highlights:

- Panel discussion between company representatives, investors and researchers
- Presentation of the responsible innovation online self-check tool
- Interactive roadmap co-creation session

Furthermore, COMPASS joined forces with [FET2RIN project](#), to highlight the challenges of investing in R&D&I projects and to present very promising technologies looking for investment – both locally and internationally. At the end of the day, a pitch session **will give the stage to 10 disruptive [future emerging technologies](#)**, that will pitch their innovation in front of the audience. A judging panel, composed by business angels, early stage investors and EU|BICs, will assess pitches during a dedicated Q&A session after each pitch. (FET projects selected to pitch will receive ad-hoc training before the event from FET2RIN experts.)
